- Have previous experience in a high school math classroom, as a teacher or teaching assistant.
- Have experience teaching Physics.
- Most importantly, possess a passion for teaching and a desire to create dynamic and challenging learning experiences that engage and inspire our students.

THE ESSENTIAL DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES OF THIS POSITION INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:

- Teach 5 sections of high school Mathematics courses where the skills of problem-solving and critical thinking are emphasized.
- Be a productive member of the Mathematics department by attending meetings, updating course curricula, seeking professional development opportunities, and supporting the goals of the department.
- Serve as an advisor to a small group of students, overseeing their academic and social growth.
- Connect with students outside of the classroom through extracurricular activities.

As a day/boarding school, on-campus faculty housing is a possibility but not a requirement. Additional duties and responsibilities are required for living on campus but the benefits of being a part of the residential community are also substantial.
